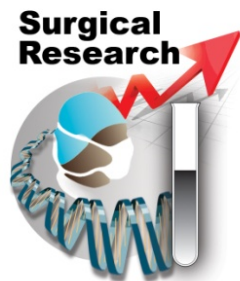


2015-2016 Departments of Pathology, Medicine, and Surgery:
