

"12 Week Rule"

If an International Medical School (IMG) graduate has spent more than 12 weeks of clerkship outside the country of his/her medical school, the medical school must be on the <u>list of approved</u> <u>schools</u> by the New York State Education Department in order to meet criteria for residency training in New York State.
