Instructions for Abstract Submission:

Abstracts must be **limited to 400 words** (excluding title, authors/addresses and phone numbers) and **follow the format below:**

- TITLE (in BOLD AND CAPITAL LETTERS)
- Authors (with department/division name, address, including e-mail address and phone number)
- When submitting abstract, include your title and the title category for which you are submitting, please indicate whether you are: Faculty, Post-doctoral Fellow, Fellow, Resident, Medical Student, Graduate Student or Undergraduate Student
- Introduction with a clear statement of the purpose of the research
- Methods (including statistical methods if possible)
- Results

- Conclusions/clinical relevance
- Funding source(s)
- If human subjects are included, indicate date/number of Committee on Research Involving Human Subjects (CORIHS) approval
- Financial disclosures should be included

Instructions for Presentations (only for notified finalists):

Each Abstract Finalist will be presenting a <u>three minute</u> power point presentation. A <u>maximum of one slide will</u> be <u>permitted</u>. The fourteen finalists (two from each category) will be notified before the event and their power point must be submitted to Jamie Trupiano by <u>Monday</u>, <u>May 17, 2021</u>.
