1. obtain approval by the GMEC prior to submission to the ACGME and/or the respective Review Committee;
2. adhere to procedures for "Approving Proposals for Experimentation or Innovative Projects" in *ACGME Policies and Procedures*;
3. monitor the quality of education provided to residents for the duration of the project;
4. obtain IRB approval, when appropriate
