Policy:

To establish an institutional policy regarding resident participation in educational and professional activities including institutional and program committees, patient safety, health care quality improvement, research and scholarly activity

The ACGME encourages residents to participate in inter-professional teams, to work collaboratively to improve patient safety and health care quality, and to participate in scholarly activity. All program directors must develop and implement programs and activities which promote residents' participation in:

- 1. Educational and professional activities and committees which carry out the aims of patient safety and improving health care quality;
- 2. Research and scholarly activity.

The GMEC will monitor these activities through regular review of the program.

GUIDELINES

Each program must provide effective educational experiences for residents that lead to measurable achievement of educational outcomes. Residents must be given the opportunity to participate in educational and professional activities that will enhance their knowledge, skills and attitudes essential to

the practice of medicine. Such activities include institutional and program committees, patient safety and quality improvement efforts, and research and scholarly activity. Professional activities include participation in local, regional and/or national professional societies. Research and scholarly activities must advance the residents' knowledge of the basic principles of research including how research is conducted, evaluated, and applied to patient care.
