Verity Schaye, MD, MHPE is an Associate Professor of Medicine at NYU Grossman School of Medicine where she practices as a hospitalist at Bellevue Hospital. In the medical school, she serves as the Assistant Dean for Education in the Clinical Sciences overseeing the clinical curriculum and assessment program. She also serves as the Assistant Director for Curricular Innovation in the Institute for Innovations in Medical Education at NYUGSoM focusing on integration of artificial intelligence in the teaching and assessment of clinical reasoning. She has been grant funded by the NBME Stemmler Fund and selected as a 2024-2025 National Academy of Medicine Scholar in Diagnostic Excellence to support advancing the use of LLMs for clinical reasoning assessment and diagnostic performance feedback. She has been an integral member of the Society to Improve Diagnosis in Medicine (now the Community to Improve Diagnosis in Medicine) having previously been selected as a fellow in Diagnostic Excellence, serving as the chair of the 2023 Diagnostic Error in Medicine meeting, and currently serving as an associate editor for the journal *Diagnosis* as well as a member of the Board of Directors for the organization. Dr. Schaye has authored numerous peer-reviewed publications and delivered invited talks nationally and internationally on clinical reasoning education and the transformative impact of AI.
