<u>Project Summary</u>: Provide (<u>attachment</u> in Word format, not to exceed 3 pages) a description of your research project proposal. Include background based on literature review, importance and rationale of project. Describe methodology, human subjects' protocol (if relevant), methods of data collection and analysis, and <u>your role in the project</u>. Specify if the project has already been formulated and activated by the international site P.I., or if the project is one of your own design. Note if a foreign institutional IRB approval has been obtained.

<u>Timetable and Outcomes</u>: Specify an approximate timetable for your participation in the project with goals and benchmarks. If you plan to complete data collection during your 2-month elective, indicate a timetable for data analysis. If the project will not be substantially completed during your elective, indicate if you will participate in interim data analysis or will continue with the project until completion. Note if you plan to develop a publishable abstract or paper based on this work and give a timetable for completion of the abstract/article.

<u>Budget</u>: Provide a budget that accounts for approximate costs of round-trip economy airfare, insurance, airport transfers, lodging, and immunizations. The usual total budget is \$3500 but in no case may the budget exceed \$4200. Expectation is that the project will require an 8-week commitment, give or take 2-3 days.

<u>Does the project involve human subjects?</u>: Y N If so, then IRB approval will be required prior to beginning the project.

<u>Personal Statement</u>: Please describe any prior research experience, international experience (not including vacation travel), foreign language(s), interest in global medicine, and your reasons for applying for this fellowship (<u>attachment</u> in Word format, not to exceed 1 page).

<u>Two Letters of Support</u>: One letter of support is to come from your Stony Brook mentor and one from your International Site mentor.
