WHAT WE OFFER

- Four-week 4th-year elective
 - Stony Brook Children's Hospital is the only children's hospital in Suffolk County, NY.
 - Rotations are offered only through VSLO.
- Participation in residency conferences and informal social activities
- One-on-one meeting with one of the Pediatric Residency Program Directors
- Faculty and peer mentorship
- Up to \$1,000 stipend for Long Island-based students to assist with travel and meal costs.
- Up to \$2,500 stipend for students from outside of Long Island to support travel and lodging expenses.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Must be in good standing at an LCME-accredited US allopathic/osteopathic medical school
- Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Must have completed USMLE or COMLEX Step 1 prior to starting the rotation.
- Must have successfully completed all third-year clerkships prior to starting the rotation.
