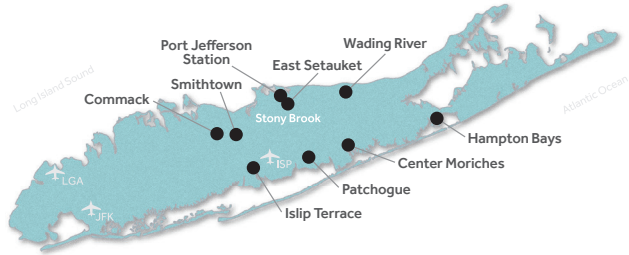
Continued High Level of Care for Your Child

If you choose a doctor in Stony Brook's primary care network, you will become part of our accredited Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH). This is a model of care in which your child's primary pediatrician becomes the point person for all of your child's medical needs, no matter the setting. This includes well-child checkups, diagnosing and treating basic childhood conditions and illnesses, necessary specialist visits, hospitalizations and surgeries. If and when any of these occur, your pediatrician will be notified and will have ongoing electronic access to your records. With our PCMH, you, your doctor and the physician team work together to manage your child's health and wellness from infancy right into adulthood.

Stony Brook has chosen to use the PCMH model of care because we believe it helps provide high-quality care and allows for all aspects of your child's medical care to be coordinated by the one doctor who knows both you and your child the best.
