Here are a few reasons!

Being a preceptor entitles you to:

- Apply for a voluntary faculty appointment in the School of Medicine. This will afford you online access to Stony Brook University libraries with vast online journals and databases.
- Apply for continuing professional education credits (“leadership activity”) for serving as a preceptor - 3 CPEUs/year and maximum 15 CPEUs/5 year recertification cycle
- Attend the monthly Nutrition Division Journal Clubs (pre-approved continuing education credits).
- Attend our annual Preceptor Appreciation Event (continuing education credit provided)
- Benefit from services Students/Dietetic Interns provide, including but not limited to:
 - Quality assurance or performance improvement projects
 - In-services, in-depth literature reviews
 - Case studies (preceptors can earn CPE credits for attending such presentations)
 - Development of patient education materials and/or marketing materials
- Share your expertise by mentoring young professionals
- The nutrition-focused physical examination: our students/interns obtain this skill which can be brought back to your facility
